Graduate School of Frontier Sciences Academic Research Grant Program 2018 - Application Guidelines –

1. Objective

The purpose of this program is to promote the research activities of graduate students enrolled in the Graduate School of Frontier Sciences (hereinafter referred to as GSFS) by providing research grants for conference presentations or fieldwork conducted outside Japan (Study abroad programs are not applicable to this grant program.).

2. Eligibility

Master's or doctoral students enrolled in GSFS (except those taking a leave of absence from the university) are eligible. However, those who will receive travel expenses or grants from other funding sources are not eligible.

3. Grant Amount

Grant amounts differ depending on the destination, as shown in the appendix below. In order for applicants to be eligible, departure from Japan for conference presentations or fieldwork must be <u>between June 2018</u> and May 2019.

4. Number of Grant Recipients

Approximately 13 students

5. Application Procedures

Those wishing to apply for this research grant must submit the following application documents to the Student Affairs Section, GSFS:

(1) Application Documents:

- 1. <u>Application form (Form 1)</u>: 2 copies (1 original and 1 photocopy).
 - * This form is 5 pages long, and to be printed on both side.
 - * 2 copies of the printed documents outlining the relevant conference or fieldwork details, if any, must be submitted.
- 2. Application Summary (Form A / Excel File): must be uploaded to the following online folder.

- (2) Application Period: From Thursday, April 5 to Tuesday, April 24, 2018
- (3) Where to apply: Student Affairs Section, GSFS (1F, Transdisciplinary Sciences Bldg., Kashiwa Campus)

6. Selection and Result Announcement

Final determination of recipients will be made by the dean after document reviews are conducted by the Support and Exchange Board. Applicants will be notified of the results at the end of May.

7. Change or Cancellation

Applicants must report to the Student Affairs Section for instructions, whether during the selection period or after the selection, in case of any changes to their application or cancellation of the conference presentation or fieldwork.

8. Report

Recipients must submit a report within one month of their return from the relevant conference or fieldwork.
