JASSO Honors Scholarship for Privately-Financed International Students

This scholarship aims to support privately financed international students in master's/doctoral courses and research students, whose visa status is "college student (留学 ryuugaku)". Students with the MEXT scholarship and any foreign governmental scholarship, are not eligible to apply.

Eligibility: Applicants must meet the following (1), (2), (3), and (4).

- (1) Academic grade point average (GPA) of last school year is 2.3 or more, and will be kept over this school year. (How to calculate the GPA is shown in the attached excel file)
- (2) Average of monthly amount of money provided by your parents, etc. is \(\frac{\pma}{9}\)0,000 or less. (Admission and tuition fee are not included.)
- (3) Recipients of other scholarships or funds can apply if their scholarship programs or funds allow them to receive JASSO Honors Scholarship.
- (4) Annual income of your financially supporter who live in Japan is less than ¥5 million.
- (5) All recipients will be obliged to cooperate in JASSO's follow-up surveys for a number of years continuously. The survey will ask you about your present employment situation.
