## JASSO Honors Scholarship for Privately-Financed International Students (Special slots)

This scholarship aims to support privately financed international students in master's/doctoral courses and research students, whose visa status is "college student (留学 *ryuugaku*)". Students with the MEXT scholarship and any foreign governmental scholarship, are not eligible to apply.

Eligibility: Applicants must meet the following conditions

- 1. Applicants must have a GPA of 2.30 or more in last academic year, and will be able to maintain the same GPA during the scholarship period. (How to calculate the GPA, refer to Applicants Data Sheet.)
- 2. Applicants must have graduated from a degree course mainly taught in Japanese or English; or have proficiency in Japanese or English at the following levels:

Japanese: JPLT level N2 or higher,

English: CEFR level B2 or higher (e.g. TOEFL iBT 72, IELTS 5.5, TOEIC L&R 785)

- 3. Applicants must agree to cooperate in the career path survey conducted by JASSO after the scholarship is granted.
- 4. Allowance (excluding enrollment fee, tuition fee, etc.) received by applicants' financial supporter such as parents must not exceed an average of 90,000 yen per month.
- 5. If the applicant has a financial supporter in Japan, his/her annual income must be less than 5 million yen.
- 6. Applicants must not be receiving a scholarship that cannot be combined with other scholarships.
- 7. Applicants must not be receiving support under JASSO's international students support program.
- 8. Those who are taking lectures or doing research in Japan.
